**2015 Talley Vineyards Chardonnay, Edna Valley - 90 Points**

The 2015 Chardonnay Edna Valley is scented of ripe apricots, apple tart and lightly buttered toast with touches of shaved almonds and nutmeg. Medium-bodied, with a lovely silkiness to the texture, it offers plenty of lively stone fruit flavor and a spicy finish.

**2015 Talley Vineyards Estate Chardonnay, Arroyo Grande Valley - 90 Points**

Opening with exuberant white peach, lemon curd and grapefruit notes with suggestions of marzipan and crushed stones, the medium-bodied 2015 Chardonnay Estate delivers refreshing citrus and mineral flavors with a racy acid line and good length.

**2015 Oliver's Vineyard Chardonnay, Edna Valley - 90+ Points**

The 2015 Chardonnay Oliver's Vineyard exudes ripe nectarines, spiced pears and applesauce with touches of coriander seed, white pepper and anise. Medium-bodied with great tension, it has a lovely satiny texture and long finish paved with pepper and spices.

**2015 Rincon Vineyard Chardonnay, Arroyo Grande Valley - 92 Points**

Offering up fragrant peach and ripe pear notes with underlying hints of salted almonds, baking bread and beeswax, the 2015 Chardonnay Rincon Vineyard coats the palate in toasty flavors, featuring a lively backbone and long finish with some mineral coming through.

**2015 Rosemary's Vineyard Chardonnay, Arroyo Grande Valley - 92+ Points**

Charging out of the gate with intense pink grapefruit, lemongrass and ripe peach notes complemented by hints of brioche and ginger, the 2015 Chardonnay Estate Rosemary's Vineyard fills the palate with creamy stone fruit and citrus flavors, supported by a racy acid line and finishing with lingering savory notes.

**2015 Talley Vineyards Pinot Noir, Edna Valley - 92+ Points**

Sporting a pale to medium ruby-purple color, the 2015 Pinot Noir Edna Valley opens with intense red currant, red cherries and raspberry leaf notes with suggestions of garrigue, forest floor, wild thyme and black pepper. Light to medium-bodied, with a beautiful quiet intensity, it has wonderfully fine tannins and a lively line carrying the gentle red berry and earthy nuances to a long finish.

**2015 Talley Vineyards Estate Pinot Noir, Arroyo Grande Valley - 90 Points**

Pale to medium ruby-purple colored, the 2015 Pinot Noir Estate reveals a lovely perfume of lavender, dried Provence herbs and dried roses over a core of fresh cranberries and Bing cherries, plus a waft of cinnamon stick. Light to medium-bodied and with great elegance in the mouth, the perfumed red fruit is nicely framed by soft, fine-grained tannins and it finishes on an earthy note.

**2015 Stone Corral Vineyard Pinot Noir, Edna Valley - 93+ Points**

Pale to medium ruby-purple in color, the 2015 Pinot Noir Stone Corral is scented of fresh mulberries, black raspberries and pomegranate with touches of black soil, stewed tea and rose hip, plus a waft of mossy bark. Light to medium-bodied, the mouthfilling intensity of delicately played flavors is impressive, framed by pleasantly chewy tannins and plenty of freshness, finishing long.

**2015 East Rincon Vineyard Pinot Noir, Arroyo Grande Valley - 91+ Points**

Pale to medium ruby-purple colored, the 2015 Pinot Noir East Rincon Vineyard is a little youthfully subdued, offering suggestions of red cherries, rhubarb and cranberries plus hints of black pepper, fallen leaves and tree bark. Light to medium-bodied, the palate is very delicate and softly spoken with the lightest grip of tannins and seamless freshness, finishing on an earthy note.

**2015 Rincon Vineyard Pinot Noir, Arroyo Grande Valley - 93+ Points**

With a pale to medium ruby-purple color, the 2015 Pinot Noir Rincon Vineyard has a nose of fragrant earth, underbrush and fungi over a core of red currants, cranberries and lavender, plus a touch of baking spices. Medium-bodied, with great intensity and expression, the earthy layers are well supported by chewy tannins and a lively backbone, finishing with a pretty herbal lift.

**2015 Rosemary's Vineyard Pinot Noir, Arroyo Grande Valley - 93 Points**

Pale to medium ruby-purple colored, the 2015 Pinot Noir Rosemary's Vineyard offers up expressive black cherries, mulberries and black raspberry notes with suggestions of violets, baking spices, fertile loam and lavender. Medium-bodied, with a firm backbone of fine-grained tannins and well-integrated freshness, it gives plenty of earthy layers and great length.
